State of
Ohio Public
Emergency

Levels

**Yellow
Level 1**

Public Emergency: active exposure and spread.

**Orange
Level 2**

Public Emergency: increased exposure and spread. Exercise high degree of caution.

**Red
Level 3**

Public Emergency: very high exposure and spread. Limit activities as much as possible.

**Purple
Level 4**

Public Emergency: severe exposure and spread. Only leave home for supplies and services.

In Person Service with transmission to parking lot

PRIVATE non-worship limited to **125** max practicing social distancing, mask mandate, **pre-approved**, designated entrances, attendee list; No other activities.

In Person Service with transmission to parking lot

PRIVATE non-worship limited to **80** max practicing social distancing, mask mandate, **pre-approved**, designated entrances, attendee list; No other activities.

In Person Service with transmission to parking lot
No Sunday School

PRIVATE non-worship limited to **50** max practicing social distancing, mask mandate, **pre-approved**, designated entrances, attendee list; No other activities.

Virtual Only

No other activities

Virtual service can be done at anytime in addition to the in person or transmitted to parking lot services.

Updated March 10, 2021

From the Ottawa County Health Department

- * A person identified as a close contact will be asked to quarantine for 14 days from their last exposure to the positive individual. A close contact is defined as a person that had close contact (within 6 feet) of the infected individual, did not have on a facial covering, and had more than 15 minutes of exposure to the infected individual. Contacts of a contact do not need to quarantine until the contact they had contact with becomes symptomatic.

St Paul UCC Response Guide

Questions to ask if contacted by congregation member about possible exposure.

Church Response

1) Has person that member came in contact with tested positive?
If answer is yes then ask next Question.

➡ If not tested or results not back: **NO ACTION BY CHURCH at this time**

2) How long ago were they in contact?

➡ If greater than 2 week : **NO ACTION BY CHURCH**

3) Has the member been at the church since exposure to positive case?

➡ If no: **NO ACTION BY CHURCH**
If yes - **clean church and notify members.**

a) Was member in "**close contact**" with infected person?

➡ If no "close contact" **NO ACTION BY CHURCH**

1) If "close contact", is member experiencing any symptoms?

➡ Clean Church and notify membership

2) If experiencing symptoms, has member been tested?

➡ Clean Church and notify membership

3) If member tested, when are results to be available?

➡ Clean Church and notify membership
